

Double the final consonant and add -ed or -ing.	Just add -ed or -ing.	Drop the final e and then add -ed or -ing.

Challenge 1: Spelling rules! In the video I explained that if the base word ends in a single consonant with a single vowel before it (hop) we have to double the final consonant before adding -ed or -ing. Can you work out the rules for the other 2 columns?

Challenge 2: Try to think of more verbs to add to your chart. Maybe you could go on a verb hunt. Are there any verbs that don't fit into these 3 rules on the table? Can you work out why and what their rule is?
