Maths

- * Count how many animals appear in the story.
- * Can you sort the animals in the story into groups? Which ones have two legs and which have four? How many ways can you sort the animals? How will you record your sorting?

Art & Design Technology

- * Draw your own map of the farmyard. Add some colour and make sure you label it.
