Literacy Skills and Challenges

* Watch and Listen to this reading of the story. <u>'Pumpkin Soup'</u>

*Help your grown up read the story with this e book. <u>Click here.</u>

*VEGETABLE SOUP – Did you make your own soup at home? Draw pictures to show each step in the process. Can you write a sentence to go with each one?

* Write your own recipe for something you've made at home e.g. a cake.

* Everyone in the story is happy when they have their own job to do. Write a list of the jobs we could give people in our classroom.

<u>Music</u>

* Squirrel plays the banjo in the story. <u>Listen to</u> <u>this banjo being played</u> in the video. Do you like the sound of this instrument? Tell your grown ups about what you think.

* Draw a map to show the different locations in the story e.g. the deep, dark woods, the old white cabin, the garden, and the steep, steep cliff.

*Draw a picture of a vegetable you've got in your home. Look closely and draw carefully. Think about its size, shape and colour.

*Make your favourite meal out of play doh.

*Design a new quilt for the animals' bed. Have a go at some sewing or cross stitch with your grown up.
