#### THE BOASTFUL TURTLE

Read the story of The Boastful Turtle (attached) and then complete the comprehension task. Begin by answering the 'Inference Focus' questions and then complete the 'Vipers Questions'. Make sure you EXPLAIN your ideas carefully and try to answer using full sentences, rather than just one word answers. For example, the first question:

1. Why was Turtle so mean to the other animals?

Turtle was so mean to the other animals because he was frustrated that he couldn't fly.

See how I looked BACK and used the question to help me write my answer in a sentence.

#### **Writing Task - Instructions**

Remember these sections:




Conclusion (what will be the result of following the instructions? Extra tips!
