Here are some challenges for your home learning this week based on the theme of 'Easter'.

## Easter

- \* Create an egg collage using materials from nature.
- \* Paint your own Easter egg rocks. Think about patterns & colours. You'll need to go for a walk first and collect some rocks the right shape.
- \* Make an Easter egg card for your family.
- \* Create a spring animal using a toilet roll tube.
- \* Make some Easter treats with your family e.g. Shredded Wheat baskets.
- \* Create your own Easter basket using recycled boxes or cartons.
- \* Draw or paint an Easter picture. You could draw Easter eggs, flowers, chicks or even the Easter bunny!
- \* Take part in the 'Egg Drop' challenge. Plan, make, test and reflect on an invention that would stop a raw egg from breaking when you drop it from a height.
- \* Go on a scavenger hunt and find these things...  
Something red, long, soft, smooth, rough, man made, round, something that has a smell, that came from a plant, that makes a noise. Draw pictures and label what you find.
- \* Create an Easter bonnet for someone in your house to wear.
- \* Design and create some packaging for a new Easter egg. Invent the new Easter egg.
