### <u>Maths</u>

\* Numbertime with BBC Schools Radio. Listen to these programmes and practise your numbers. <u>Click here.</u>

\* Watch and learn with Mrs Phillips' maths videos on the school website each day. <u>Click here</u> to choose a video.

\* Reception – use these number videos to practise understanding numbers to 20. <u>Click here.</u>

\* Find 20 objects outdoors (twigs, pebbles etc) Practise counting them. Take some away and count again. Write the numbers 1–20 on them. Ask your grown up to take one away. Work out which number is missing. Mix them up and put them back in the right order. Try ordering them backwards from 20 to 1.

\*Year 1 – use these videos to practise 'Money' skills. <u>Click here.</u>

\* Grab a handful of coins. Add the amounts and work out how much money you have. Take one coin away. How much have you got now?

\*Ask your grown ups to write down an amount of money. See if you can use coins to make that amount of money. try making different amounts with your coins.

# Literacy

\*Practise reading every day, even if it's just a few pages. Use books from home or school, or use Oxford Owl online to read and listen to e books. Choose the colour the same as your school books to get started. <u>Click here</u> to use Oxford Owl.

\*Draw a picture and write about something you enjoyed on your Easter holiday. Include lots of detail and focus on your writing. Bring it to school next week to share with the class.

#### \*Keep a diary this week

Draw a picture and write about what you have been doing each day this week. Stretch yourself and try hard with your writing.

### \*Outdoor alphabet

Try and find something outdoors that begin with each letter of the alphabet e.g. a – ant, b – bugs, c – car, etc. Can you remember all the letters in the alphabet? Can you write them down?

\*Watch and practise Phonics with Mrs Phillips' videos on the school website each day. If you're not sure which phase to use, send me an email and I will let you know. <u>Click here</u> to get started.

\* Animal facts – the Wildlife Park is now open so why not take a trip to see the animals. Think about your favourite animal. Talk about what you know about it, then ask questions about what you would like to know about it. Try and find out the answers to your questions. Draw a picture of your favourite animal, write labels to show the different parts of the animal and then have a go at writing about it. Bring your learning to school next week to share with the class.

## <u>Outdoors</u>

- \* Ride your bike, or practise learning to ride your bike.
- \*Play outside with your grown ups or brothers and sisters. Can you invent a game to play? What will the rules be?
- \*Help make a picnic and eat it outdoors. It could be in your garden or somewhere further away.
- \*Go exploring. There are so many places to go for a walk. Try the Curraghs, the beach, the plantations.
- \*Make your own den. Where will you build it? What materials will you use? How big will it be? There is so much thinking, planning and problem solving involved in den building. Have a go!
- \*Take your dog for a walk.
- \*Go on a 'Spring' hunt. Can you spot any baby animals? How many different flowers can you find? Draw pictures of them.
- \* Help with the gardening See what jobs you can help with in the garden. Planting, weeding, digging, watering are great jobs to help with in the garden.
