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The main comments are summarised below. Comments in red refer to our response.

Constructive Criticism:

*Some parents feel they aren't kept informed about how their child is getting on and don't know if their child is making progress, it was generally noted that this was because parents evenings have been disrupted due to lockdowns (Written reports are out on June 3rd and parents evenings are on June 29th/30th. Post lockdown we will return to our usual parents' evenings and a final written report. There will also be an open evening in October).

*One suggestion was to find another way of rewarding/celebrating learning rather than Star Learner (this is currently under review in order to be more inclusive but still based on intrinsic motivation).

*Can we introduce additional homework but make it optional (this will happen when we embed our new Cornerstones Curriculum. Home learning suggestions will return next term when the Parent Leaflets are reintroduced).

*Some parents aren't sure how to help their child at home (we'll review this in September)
