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The tables below give information on the achievement and attainment of all children for the year ending July 2021. Expected attainment for year 2 children is level 2b and expected attainment for year 6 is level 4b. Please note that at this point reception children had missed a term of school whilst other children had missed a total of two terms through lock downs. Thank you for all the support families showed us and each other through those difficult times.

Please also remember that the attainment data is only a snapshot of the attainment by a group of children at a moment in time. It does not show the range of additional needs or pupils who have transferred into our school. The most important data is the achievement data as it shows a child's progress from a given starting point.

Progress is the true measure of success for children as it demonstrates improvement over time. Teachers assess children's learning continually through questions, observations, tasks etc. This allows them to determine what a child knows now and what they need to learn next. This basic philosophy drives our teaching for learning as we strive to offer as personalised a curriculum as is possible for each child.

It is also important to remember that many aspects of a child's learning are unmeasurable. We do a great deal of work on developing the capacity to learn and think effectively and there isn't any data that demonstrates the children's successes in this.
