Allergies - IMPORTANT!

We now have some children in school with severe allergies to nuts and dairy products. Current advice is that these items should not be banned from school as this leads to a false sense of security and can put a child at risk. **However, it is important that you or your child tell the class teacher if they have brought any nut and/or dairy products in for lunch or snacks so we can ensure children with allergies are not directly exposed to them.** Thank you.

Breakfast club

Please make sure enrolment forms are brought in so that the ladies running the club have up to date information about your child. New forms can be obtained from the office. Thank you.

Water bottles

As we are no longer able to provide cups, please ensure your child has a **named water bottle** in school so they can access water whenever they need it. As part of the Jubilee Celebrations, the Andreas Commissioners have kindly provided each child with a water bottle so feel free to use that one!

PE kits

Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school **at all times.** This includes pumps, shorts and a t-shirt. We will be having more PE sessions this year as we are focusing on developing PE skills and so an available kit is essential. All kits can then be taken home and washed at half term.

Swimming

Swimming starts on Friday, 16th September for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6. All children should swim unless they are ill in which case you need to contact school to confirm their absence.
