Our Topic is Once Upon a Time

In the **Once Upon a Time** project, your child will be introduced to the wonderful world of stories. They will listen to a range of traditional tales and have the chance to act out the stories in their play. They will also listen to alternative contemporary stories to see different viewpoints from the characters. They will use the stories to think about how life has changed from when the stories were written. They will also make up their own stories and make masks, props and puppets to act out their stories. A Home Learning Pack to support this topic is attached if required.

Physical: Callum our MSR coach will continue to coach basic ball and games skills on Wednesday mornings. Children will develop writing skills during Write Dance and Action Kid lessons each week.

Creative: Working with Mrs Manser children will explore their understanding of journeys and adventures.

ICT: Develop independence accessing e-books through the new school system

Personal and Emotional: Children will be excited to share with you the many different emotions they meet through a transport themed quiz.

Other Areas of Learning:

We will have a strong focus on our Learn Without Limits and begin looking closely at the Thinking Moves alphabet so we can recognise the best thinking for our learning!

Writing: We will be sending home the first phase of dry-wipe handwriting formation sheets for you to practice at home if you so wish. Starting points and number of strokes are very important to develop fluent writing skills. A little regular practise at home is hugely beneficial.
