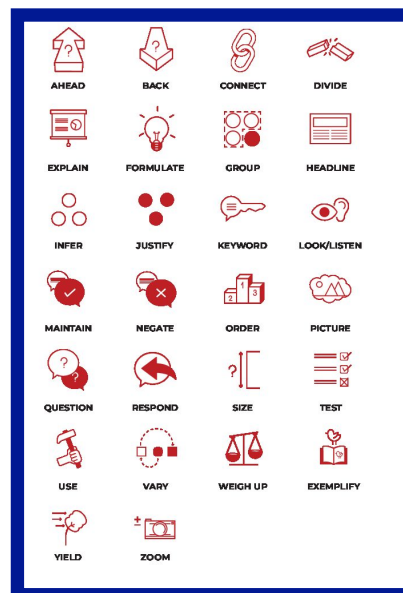


Writing: poetry, autobiographies and story writing.

Our Topic is 'Urban Pioneers'

Hop on the bus and take a trip downtown, where the lights are bright and every street has a story to tell. This term, we'll visit our local town. We'll photograph urban art including graffiti, murals and statues. We'll investigate cities around the world and find out how they've changed over time. Please see the attached home learning ideas.
