Our Topic is Road Trip USA!

Buckle up and put your sunglasses on – this half term we're going on a road trip across the USA! We'll start by 'visiting' the states where Native American tribes settled. We'll conduct research and write postcards to family members. Using maps, we'll locate the USA and find the names of the states. Then we'll cook delicious traditional dishes.

Science: Construct operational simple series circuits using a range of components and switches for control. Describe materials as electrical conductors or insulators.
