#### Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back! I hope you all had a wonderful Summer holiday despite the unseasonal weather! The children are already enjoying learning in their new classes and early indications are new staff and pupils are settling well.

## **Allergies - IMPORTANT!**

We have some children in school with severe allergies to nuts and dairy products. Current advice is that these items should not be banned from school as this leads to a false sense of security and can put a child at risk. However, it is important that **you or your child tell the class teacher** if they have brought any nut and/or dairy products in for lunch or snacks so we can ensure children with allergies are not directly exposed to them. Please be aware that lots of plant based products contain nuts. Thank you.

#### **Breakfast Club**

Please make sure enrolment forms are brought in so that the fantastic volunteers running the club have up to date information about your child. New forms can be obtained from the office. Thank you.

### Water bottles, uniform and kit

Please ensure your child's PE kit and uniform are all **labelled.** Staff are not as proficient at identifying clothing by smell as some of our pupils are! All water bottles should be clearly named so pupils can access water whenever they need it. Cups are <u>not</u> provided. The **named PE** kits should be in school everyday - thin soled black pumps, shorts and a house coloured t-shirt. PE kits will be sent home half termly for washing.

### **Second Hand Uniform**

Mrs Robinson has a great selection of good quality pre-loved school uniform school would like see re-used. If you need anything please let Mrs Robinson know. They are available at a very small cost and proceeds go to school fund. Please ensure you clearly **label** these.

## SPORTS - Swimming/Clubs and MSR

Swimming starts on Friday, 13th September for Years 3, 4, 5 & 6. All children should swim unless they are ill in which case you need to contact school to confirm their absence. It is essential that all children have the right swimming attire as they will not be allowed to swim otherwise. A separate email with attire and DESC expectations will be sent to all KS2 parents shortly.

<u>Before/After School CLUBS</u> - We will be offering a before school FUNdamental Skills Club for Year 1 and Year 2 on a Wednesday. Reception pupils will be able to sign up after Christmas. Children need to be in the school hall for 8.30am. Trainers may be brought from home to be worn. An after school Sports Club will be offered on a Thursday for a variety of year groups and will support MSR competitions/festivals. Starting from Thursday 19th September, we will be offering Hockey to <u>all KS2</u>. There will be a festival of hockey for northern schools at RGS on October 14th for a <u>Year 3/4 team only</u>. We will select our team from children who have attended the club. After Christmas we will be offering Tag Rugby to Years 2&3 only, followed by Kwik Cricket for Years 3 ,4,5 and 6 in preparation for a Year5/6 team event.

**MANX Lessons** - Years 4, 5 and 6 will each have a term of Manx Language lessons. These will be on a Monday afternoon. Term 1 Y5, Term 2 Y 6, Term 3 Y4.
