Winter Weather

If conditions deteriorate during the day, we will communicate directly with you via text message, as well as our Facebook page. Please try and avoid ringing the school as this can tie up our phone line and prevent us from consulting with officers of the Department.

Rainy Mornings - On rainy mornings we open our classroom doors at 9.00am when the staff team will take responsibility for the children. There is no need for parents to wait with their children until 9.10am, you can simply drop and go.
