


WHITE ROSE MATHS HOME LEARNING


Writing: poetry, short narrative and posters.

Our Topic is Playlist!

What's that noise? A crash? A shake, a rattle or a low, bass hum? Which do you prefer – an acoustic singer or a booming brass band? A solitary voice singing sweetly and quietly or a magnificent choir lifting the roof? Take out your ear plugs as you journey through the valley of sound and find out about instruments, the sounds they make and how they are produced. Discover how sounds are made and which sounds travel the furthest.

Science: Explain how sounds are made and heard using diagrams, models, written methods or verbally. Compare how the volume of a sound changes at different distances from the source.

P.E.: MSR sessions. Swimming. Gymnastics.

ART: Create a series of sketches over time to develop ideas on a theme or mastery of a technique.

DT: Investigate and identify the design features of a familiar product.

Music: Compare and evaluate different genres of music using appropriate musical vocabulary. Improvise and compose a sequence of sounds and vocals for different instruments and record them using standard or invented notation.

ICT: Manipulate a range of text, images, sound or video clips and animation for given purposes.
